Your completed form should be individual. Any joint  
declaration will be treated as 50/50 and therefore  
you must ensure that each party pays enough tax for  
your portion of the donation.

You will need to pay enough tax in the tax year to  
cover all the tax that will be reclaimed by Ebenezer  
and any other organisations to whom you are making  
Gift Aid donations.

By signing this form you are confirming your under-  
standing that if you do pay less tax than the amount  
reclaimed on all donations you have made in a tax  
year, it is your responsibility to pay any difference.

It is essential that you advise Ebenezer if your per-  
sonal circumstances change to avoid the church claim-  
ing a tax refund we are not entitled to. This will in-  
clude change of name, address or your employment  
status.

You can cancel your declaration at any time and will  
need to do so if you no longer pay enough tax.
